 - i. Parents often want their students to be involved in academic activities over the summer.
 - g. Goal 1: Looks good.
 - i. Make sure that when we renew iReady, students don't lose all their data. We have kept better track of students this year, so we shouldn't have a problem.

 - a. That's something we can look into next year.
