Administration of Medication: Emergency Administration of Opiate Antagonist

School nurses may provide initial and annual refresher training to available and interested school employees in regards to the storage and emergency use of opiate antagonists. The training and accompanying written materials shall include:

1. Techniques for recognizing an opiate-related drug overdose event;
2. Standards and procedures for storage and emergency use of an opiate antagonist; and
3. Emergency follow-up procedures, including calling the emergency 911 number and contacting, if possible, the student's parent/legal guardian and physician.

Secondary schools (7-12) may store and make readily available at least one (1) opiate antagonist available for use by trained personnel qualified to administer it under this policy.
