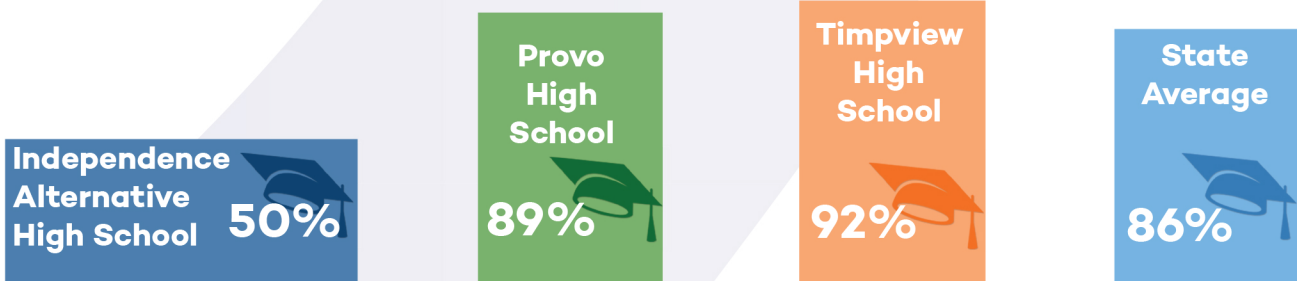

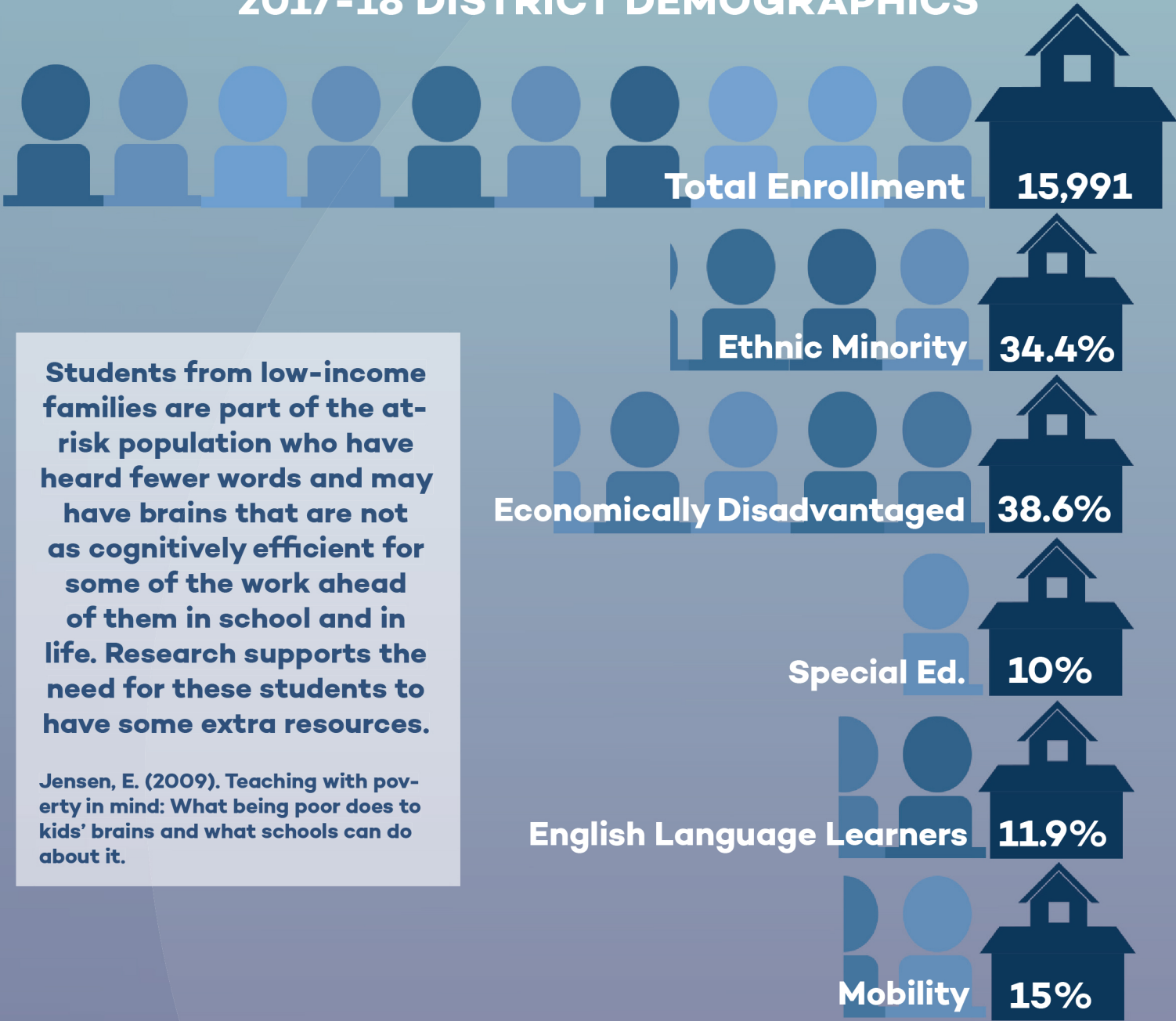
According to the Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention, “nearly one-fifth (19%) of juvenile violent crimes occur in the four hours between 3 p.m. and 7 p.m. on school days.” Afterschool programs provide opportunities for students during much of this time frame.
