Policy No. 3360

District Notification Of Juvenile (Student) Offenders

Within three days of receiving information from the juvenile court or a law enforcement agency, the district superintendent (or his designee) shall notify the principal of the school the juvenile attends or last attended.

Upon receipt of the information, the principal shall make a notation in a secure file other than the student's permanent file, and if the student is still enrolled in the school, notify staff members who should know of the adjudication.

A staff member receiving information may only disclose the information to other persons having both a right and a current need to know.
