**Administration of Medication: Student Possession and Self-Administration of Asthma Medication**

Students are permitted to possess and self-administer asthma medication (prescription or nonprescription, inhaled medication) if:

1. The student's parent or guardian completes with the school nurse and health care provider the "Asthma Action Plan" form authorizing and confirming:
  - a. that the student is responsible for, and capable of, self-administering the asthma medication; and
  - b. it is medically appropriate for the student to self-administer asthma medication and be in possession of asthma medication at all times; and
  - c. the name of the asthma medication prescribed or authorized for the student's use.

Authorization for the ability to carry and/or self-administer medication may be denied or withdrawn by the school at any time following actual notice to the student's parent/legal guardians.
