Best Practices: Seal Use

- Awards given on behalf of Provo City School District
- Commencement programs and related materials
- Diplomas
- Employment offer letters
- Invitations from the Office of the Superintendent
- Stationery from the Office of the Superintendent
- Legal documents

Incorrect Logo Usage

- 1. Never combine the seal with the logo
- 2. Do not use colors other than the Blue, Green and Orange of the logo
- 3. Do not use the logo as a window for imagery

- 4. Do not add shadows or other special effects to the logo
- 5. Do not alter the proportions of the logo
- 6. Do not substitute the logo with typed text
- 7. Do not reconfigure/change the position of aspects of the logo
- 8. Do not place the logo over a color of similar value
- 9. Do not use the logo in outline form
- 10. Do not create a container for the logo
- 11. Do not use the logo over any busy image
- 12. Do not create or add any artwork to the logo
- 13. Do not position the logo on angles

Incorrect Seal Usage

- 1. Do not change the colors of any part of the seal
- 2. Never combine the seal with the logo
- 3. Do not crop the seal
- 4. Do not alter the proportions of the seal
- 5. Do not create or add any artwork to the seal
