The person making the nomination is required to share this official documentation as part of the application.

Special Cases

On a case-by-case basis the Provo City Board of Education can choose to award an honorary diploma to other citizens of Provo City who did not graduate from district high schools. The Board will determine the criteria for that decision but may consider these:

- An individual who has made a notable contribution of time, talents or resources to an individual high school or the community
- An individual who inspires and encourages current and past Provo City students
- A community member who achieves state or national prominence
- A member of the Provo City business, civic, health, education or philanthropic community that has made a significant contribution to the local community
