Megan Motions, Brad seconded Approval of the minutes.

Sean Faherty is unable to continue. We need to appoint someone to replace him from the counsel. Is there interested parents that are available? Ryan may have a name. They spent some time reviewing data from the school. Megan talked about how to review that data when there are parents that are worried about giving the state information. Many people opt out, which makes gathering data difficult. 80% opt out of standardized test scores.
