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Use the **Spellchecker** to check the spelling of words in constructed-response fields. The spellchecker only gives an indication that a word is misspelled; it does not provide the correct spelling. **Note:** The spellchecker is only available for Writing.

Text-to-Speech (including Descriptive Audio)

- Text-to-speech is auto-enabled for all students.
- With Text-to-speech enabled, the test automatically reads and highlights the question and, for certain types of questions, the available answers using a device's speaker.
- Text-to-speech includes a *Play from Here* tool, which allows students to select the starting point to hear the text.

To use Text-to-Speech

- a) Click the play/pause icon to play/pause the reading and highlighting.
- b) Drag the volume indicator to the left to decrease or to the right to increase the volume.
- c) To use *Play From Here*, right-click the desired starting point in the text (long press for iPads).

d) Double click *Play From Here* to begin playing from the starting point that was selected and play through the end of the question text or answer text.
