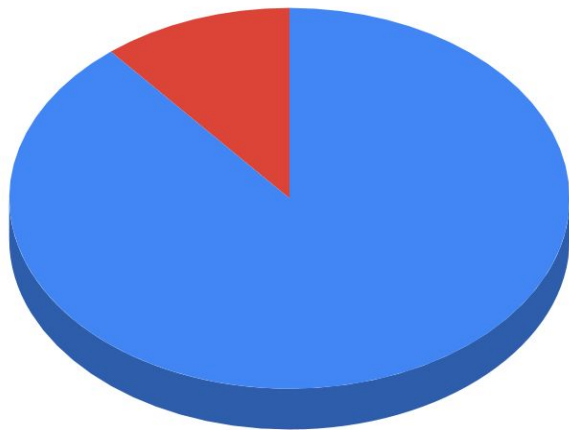

How prepared did you feel to teach online?

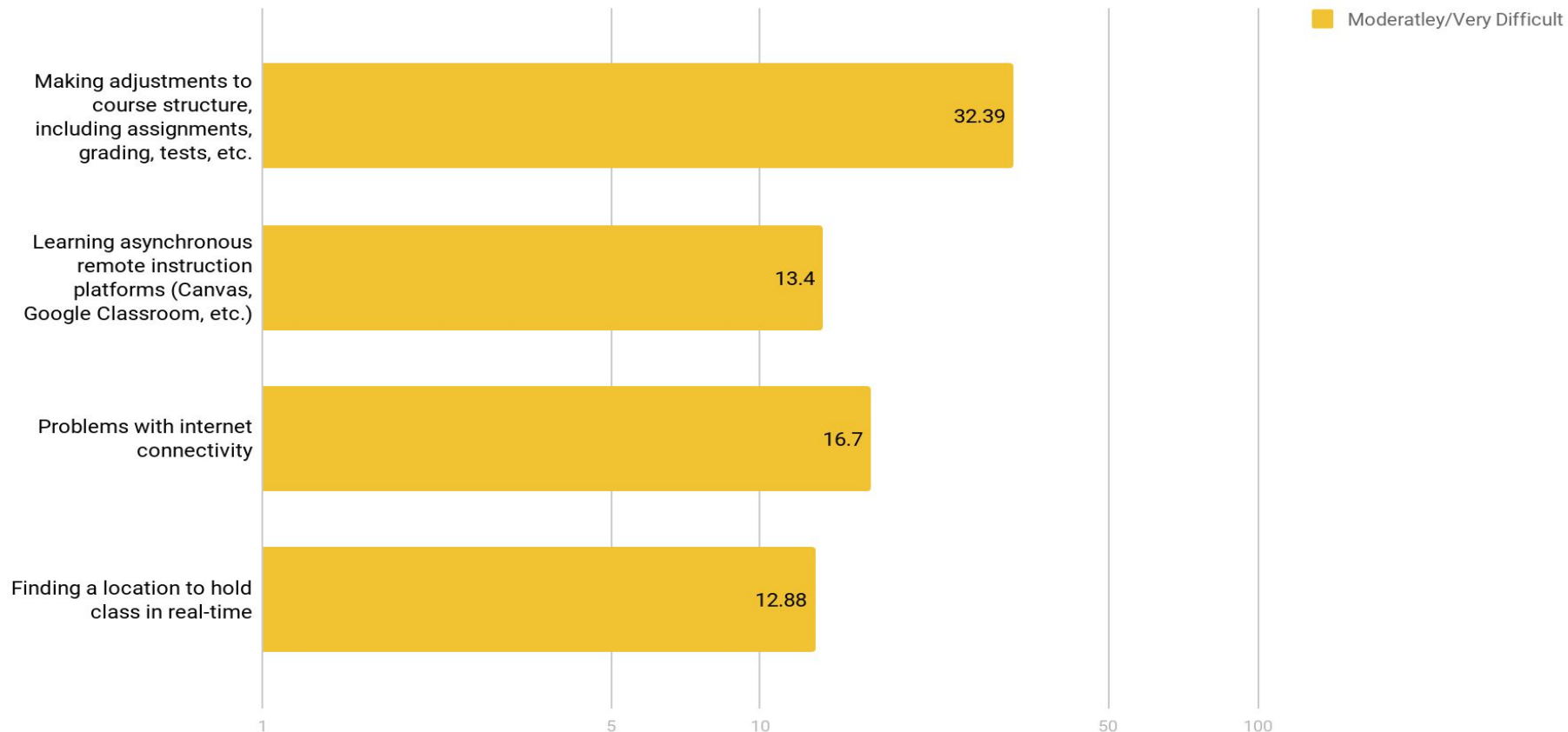

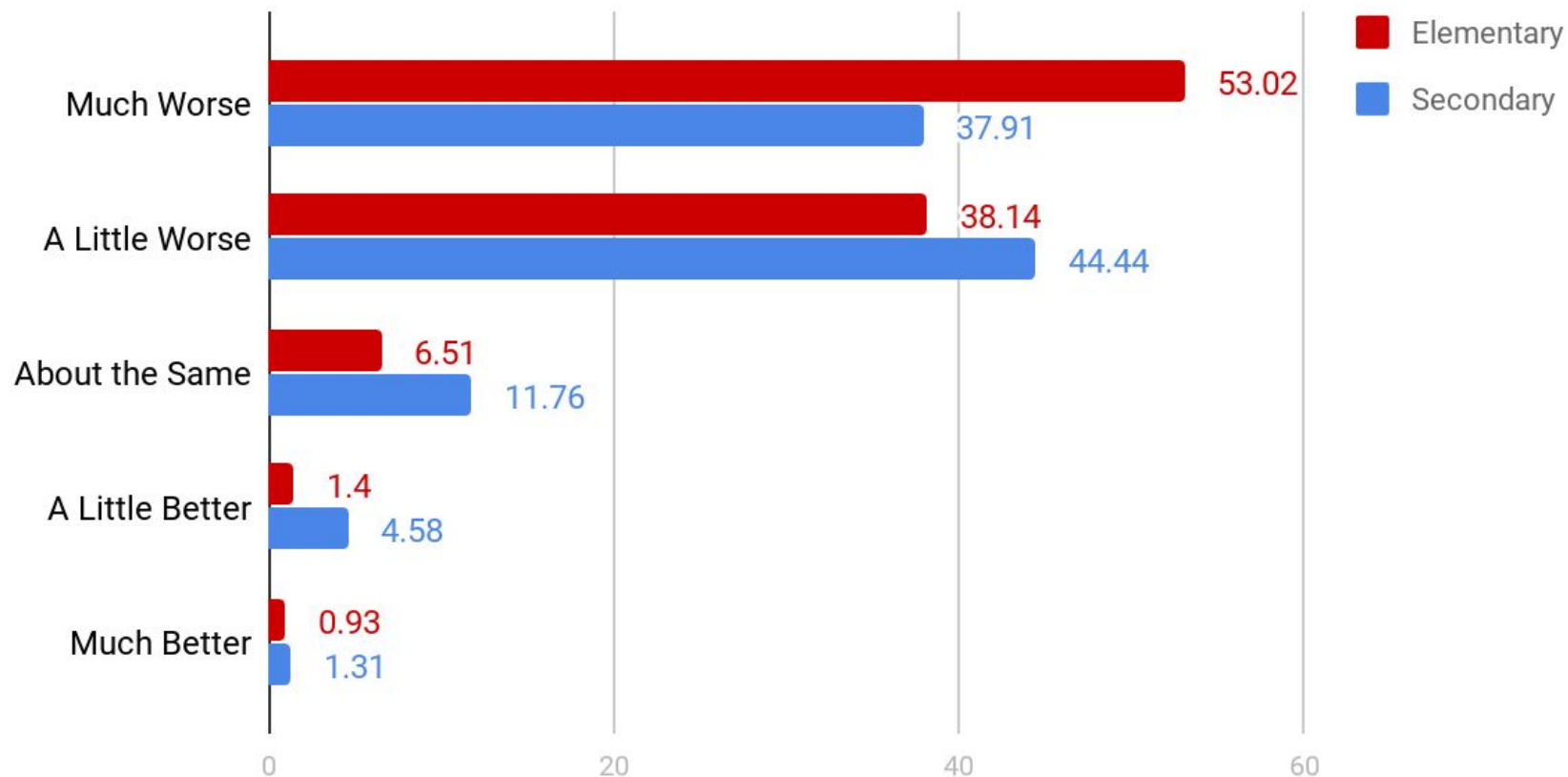

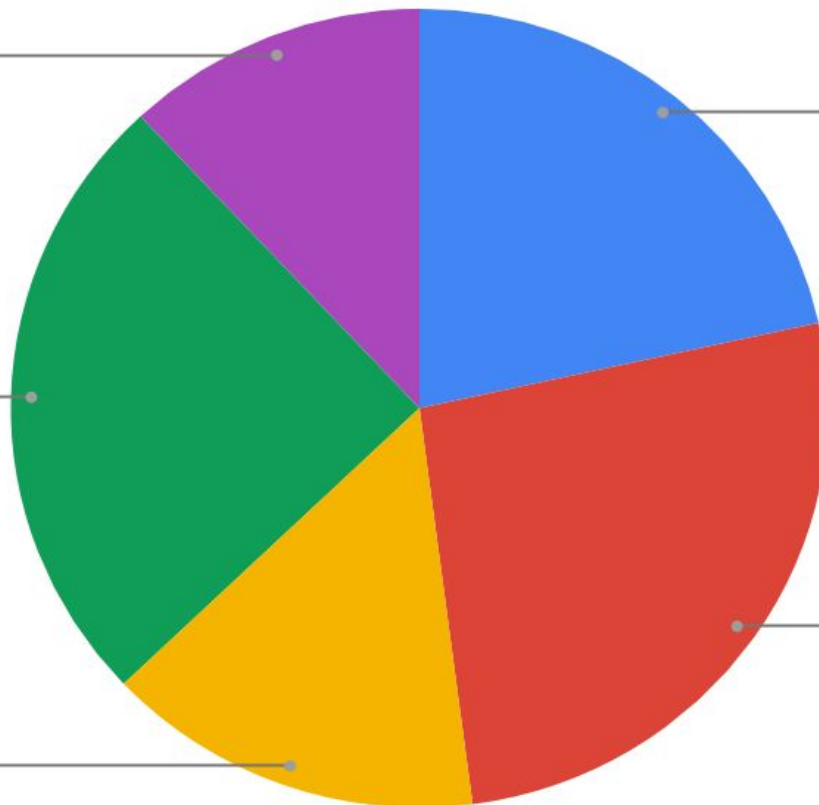

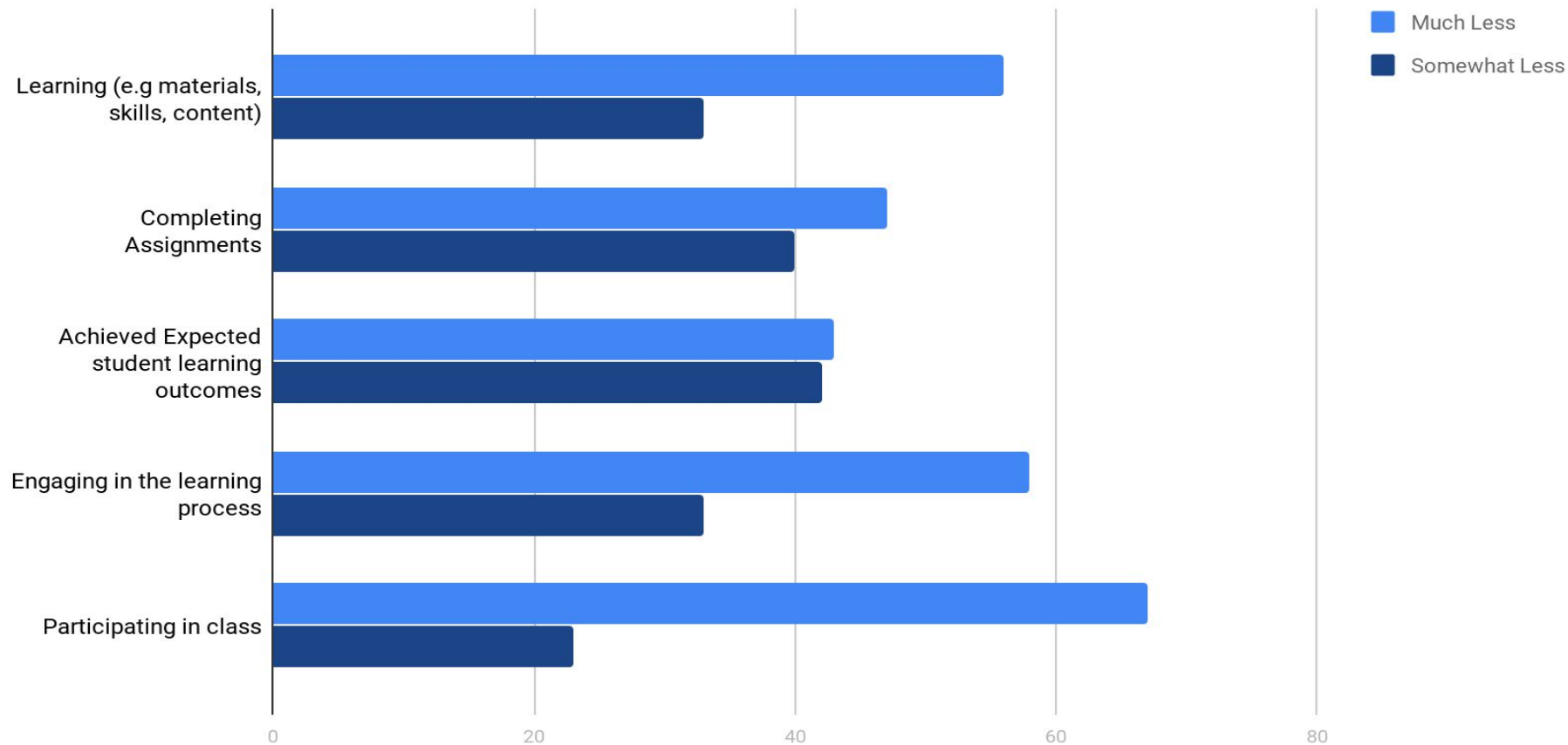

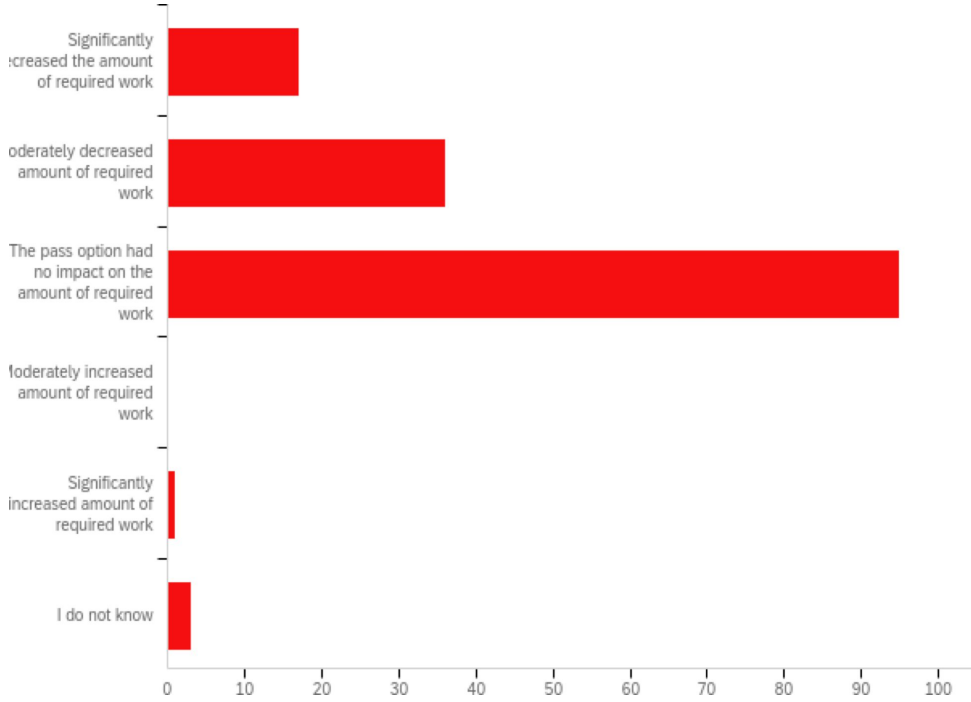


What do you want to learn to be a more effective instructor?

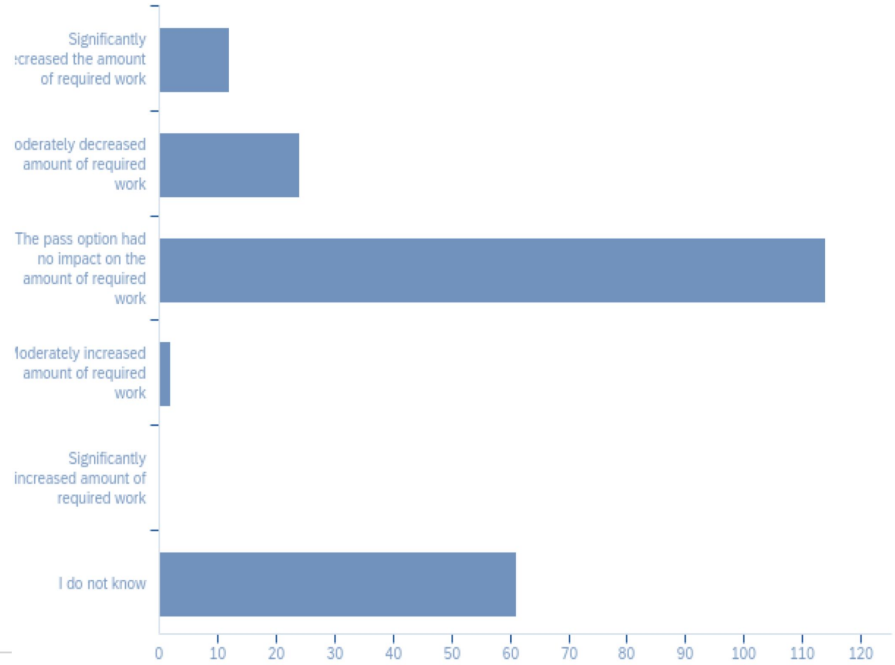

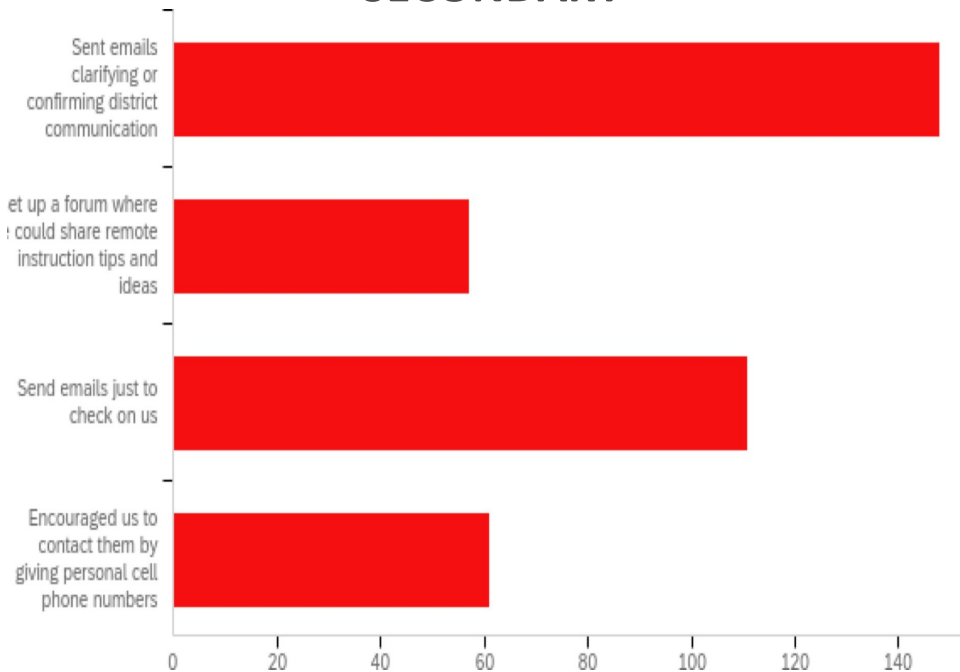

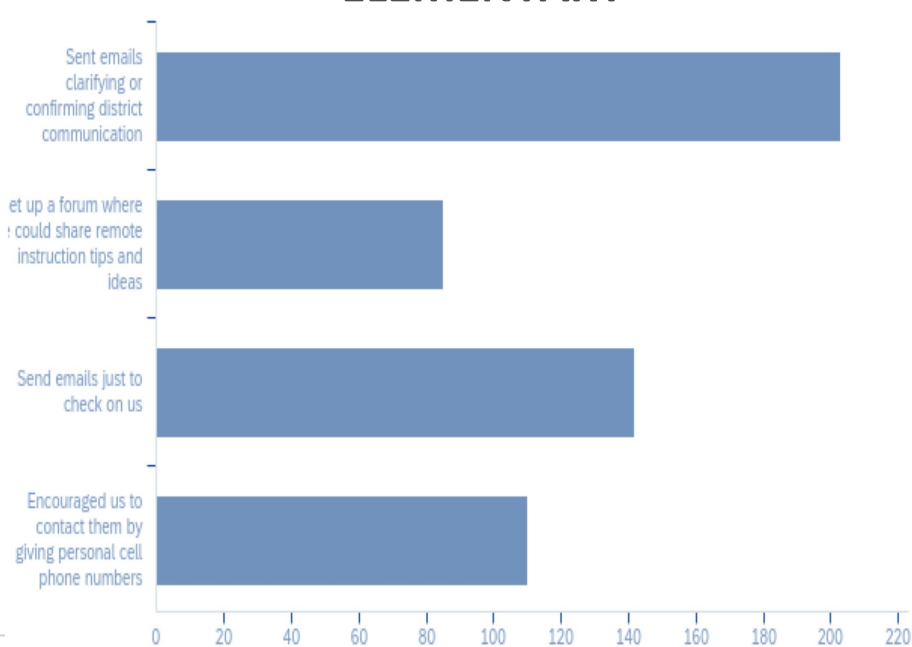


Which of the following did your school leadership do to help support you in remote instruction? (select all that apply)

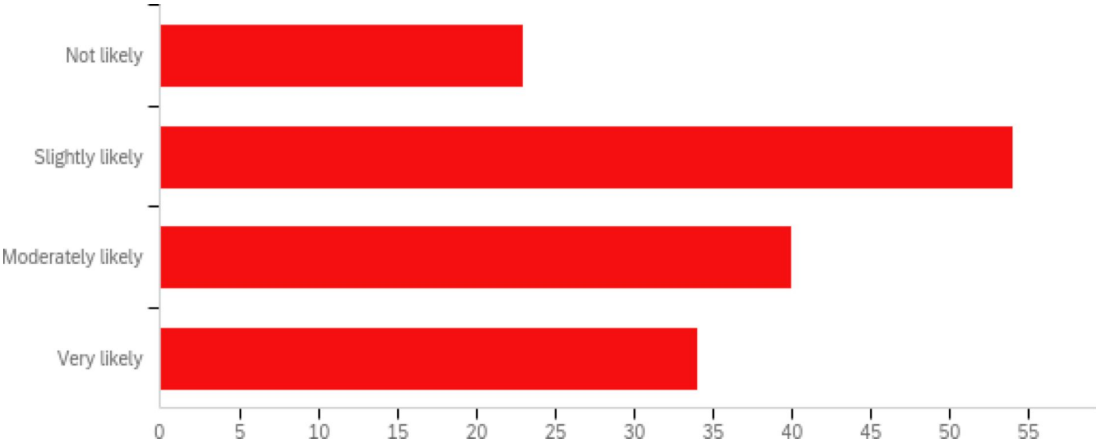

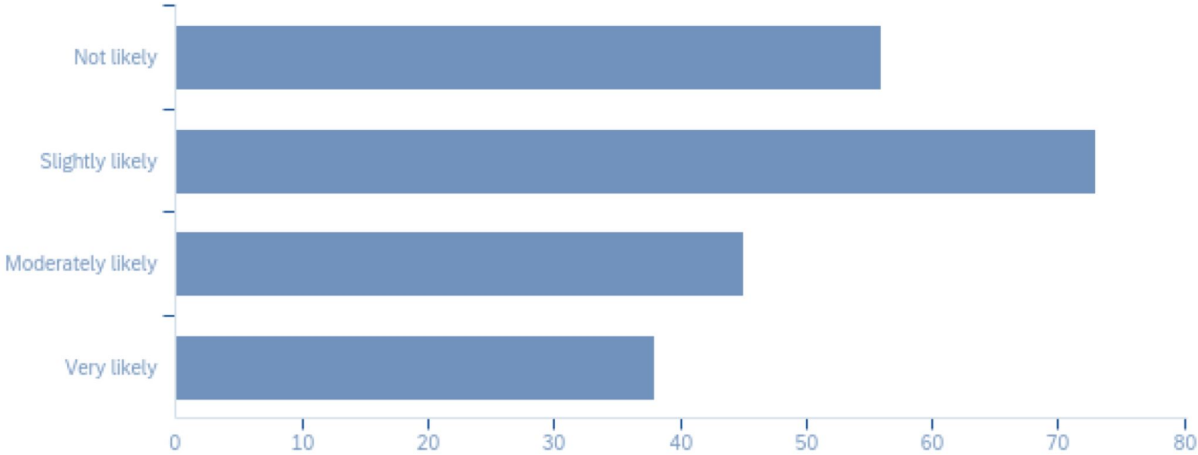


How likely are you to incorporate remote instruction strategies once we return to holding classes in-person?

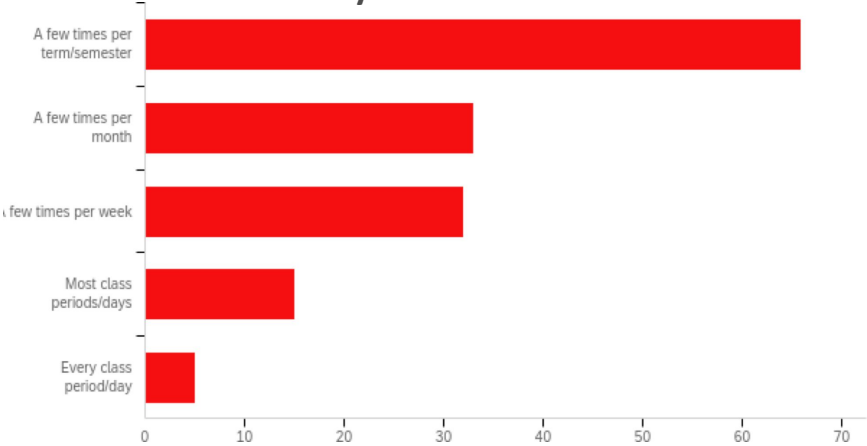

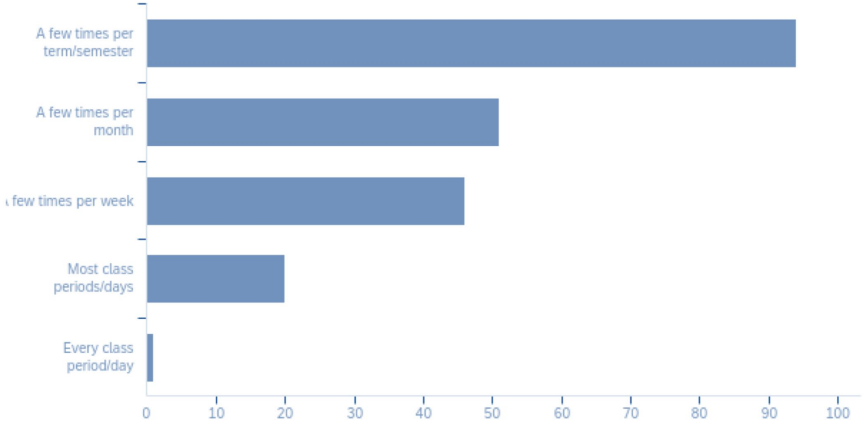


Going forward, in a typical term/semester, how often would you plan to use remote instruction strategies as part of your class?

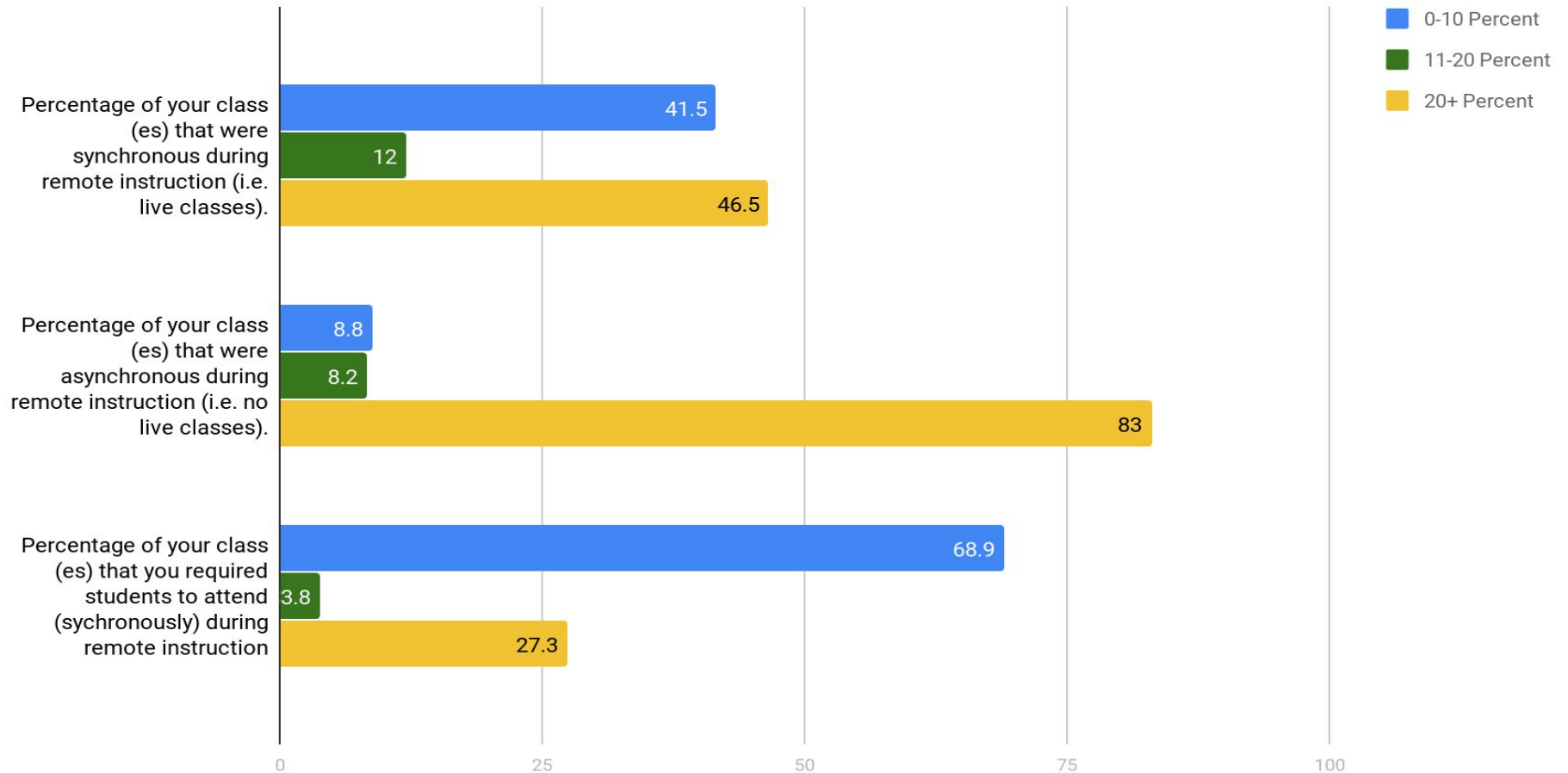

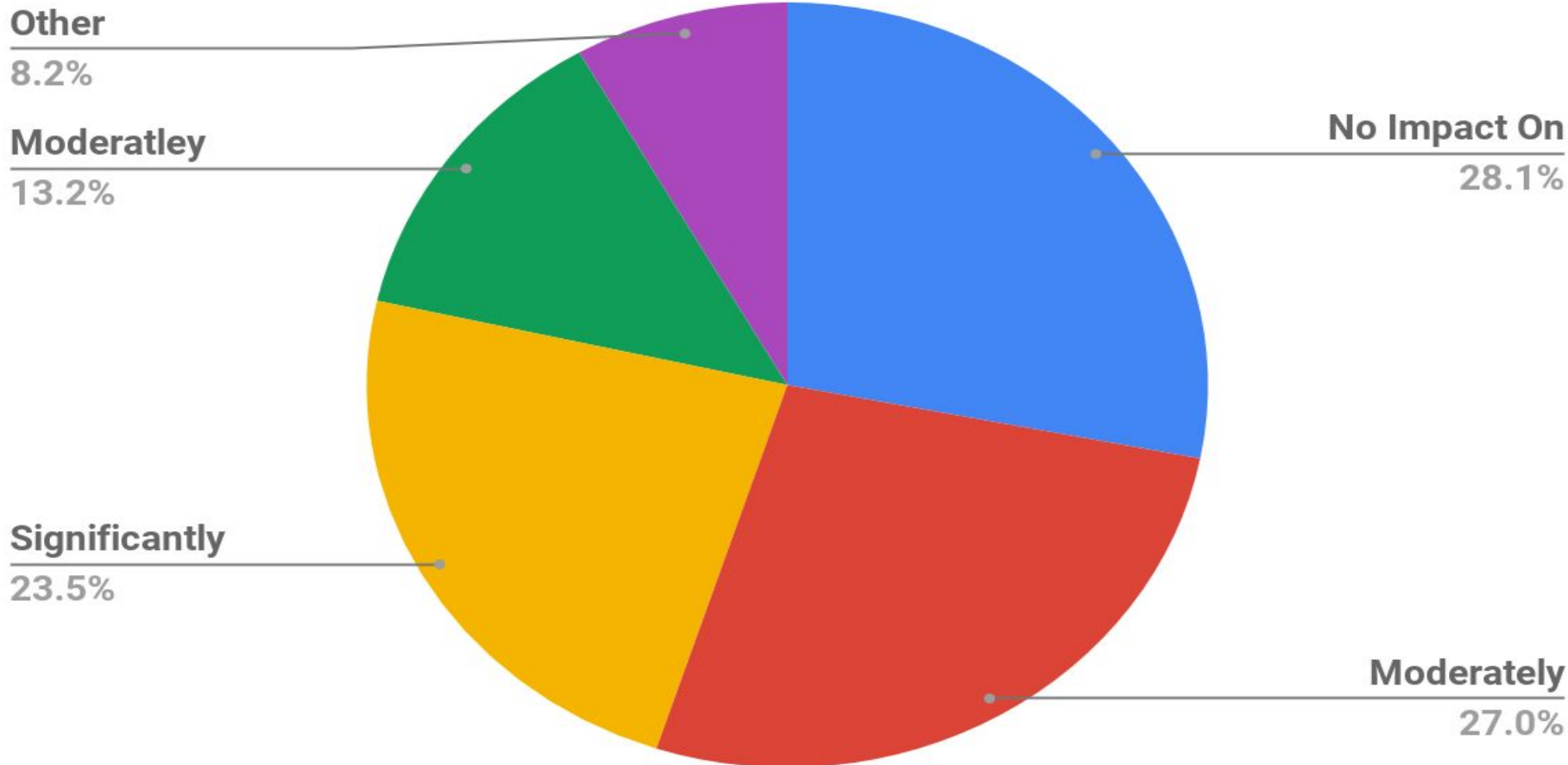

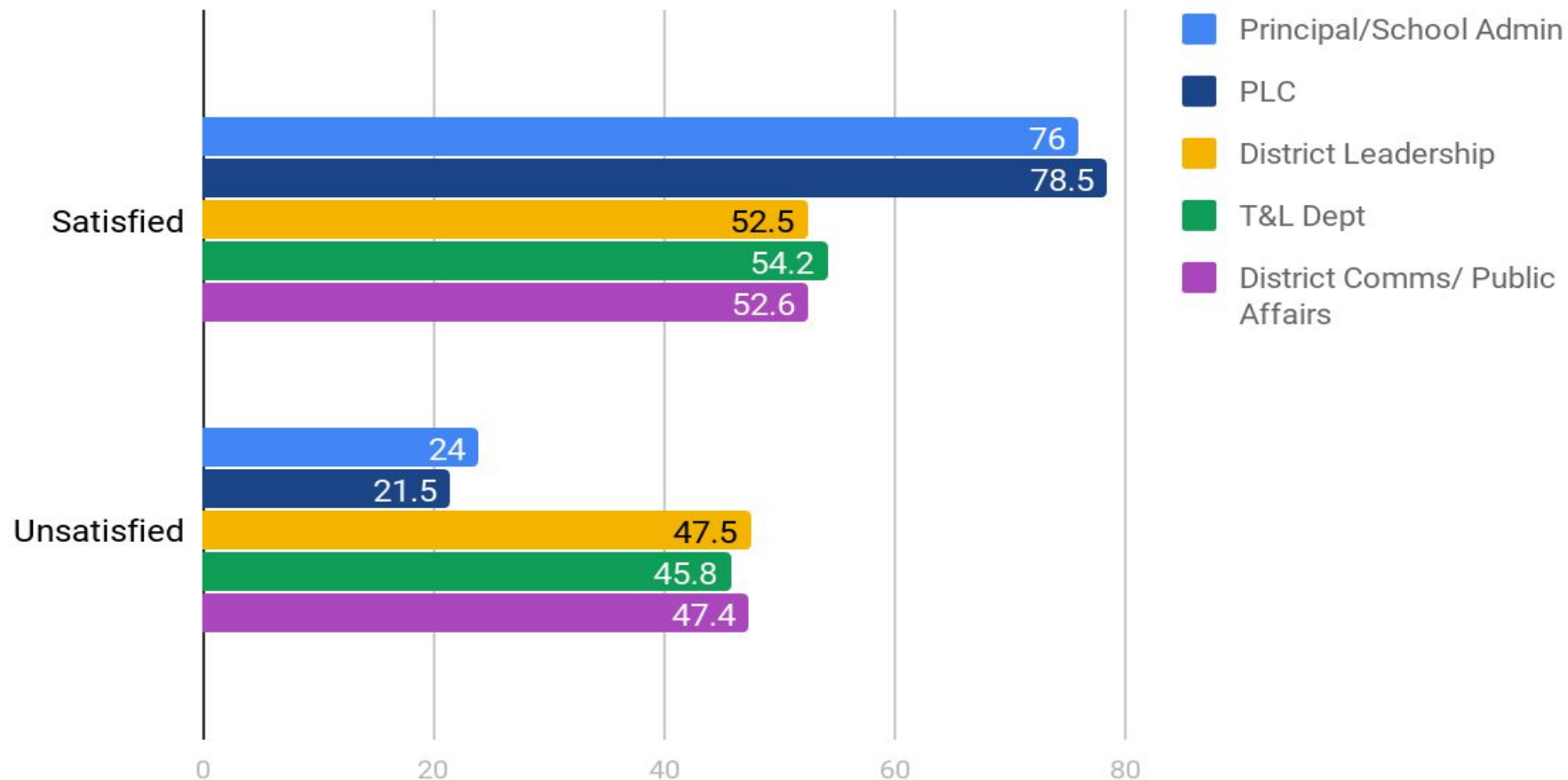

In what ways was your PLC supportive during the remote instruction transition?

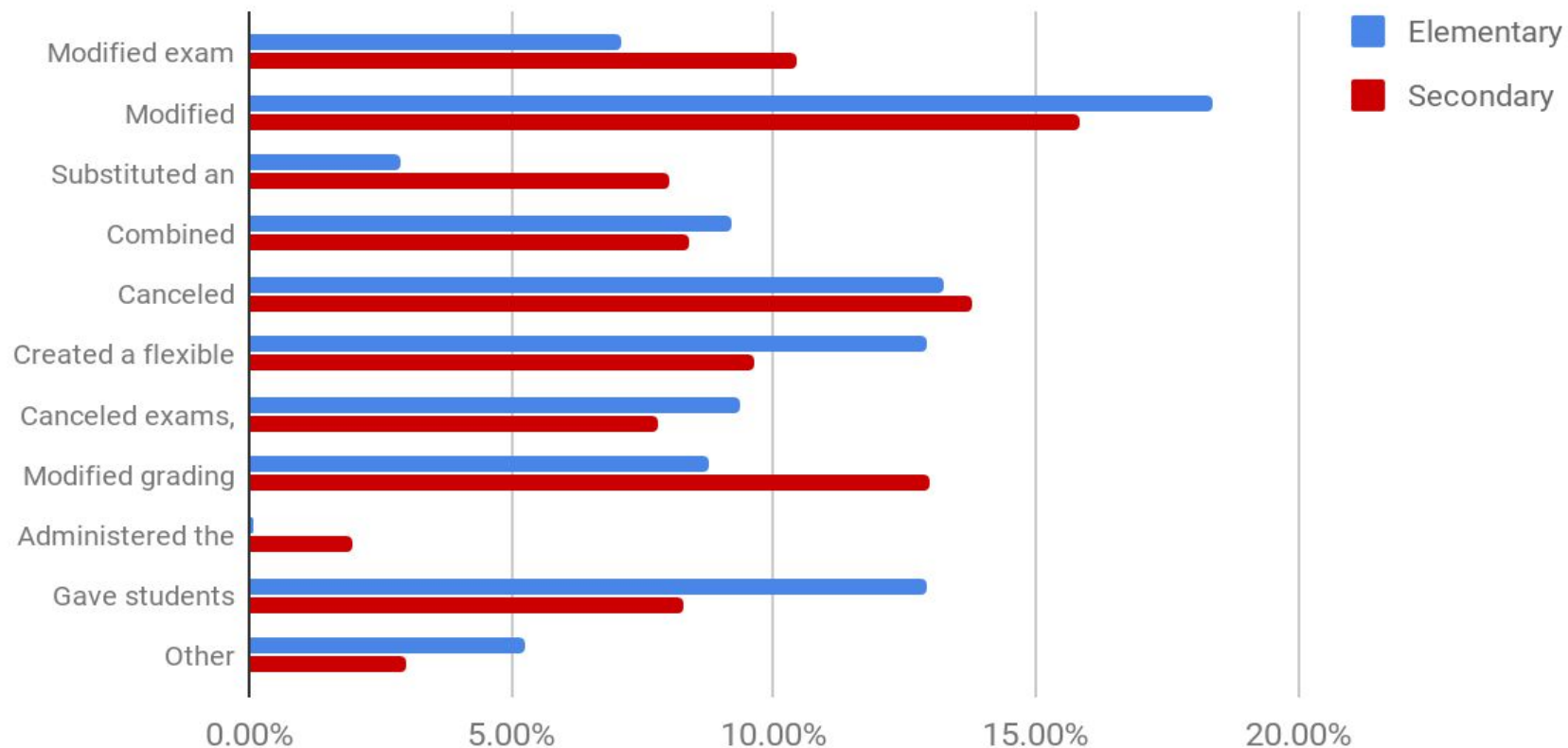
