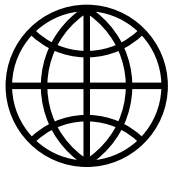
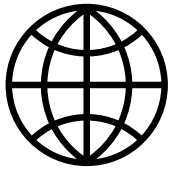




The Utah Seal of Biliteracy will be awarded to those who demonstrate proficiency in English and one or more world languages or the indigenous languages of Navajo or Ute. The seal is placed electronically on the student's high school transcript.



The seal encourages students to pursue biliteracy, honors the skills they attain, and can be evidence of skills that are attractive to future employers and college admissions offices.



To apply for a Seal of Biliteracy you must:

- Meet with a counselor to determine if you qualify.
- Gather appropriate assessment scores and/or register to take any necessary assessments.
