Community Council Help Needed

The State of Utah receives proceeds from public land leasing of oil, gas, and other entities. These funds are sent to schools and require each school to have a community council to dictate where and how these funds are expended for the students in those schools. According to the law, we must have the principal, and at least one employee member on the council and at least two or more parents than staff members to serve. Therefore, we need four parents to serve on our council for eSchool. Currently, we have three parents who have volunteered to serve and we need at least one more. There will be about six or seven meetings during the year, each lasting about an hour to 70 minutes, so the time commitment is roughly 6-8 hours for the whole year. And, all of the meetings will be held via Zoom, so no travel or in-person meetings will be held during the year. We need one more volunteer as soon as possible as we are required to have our council membership up and running by October 1. Thank you in advance for your consideration.

Participation Requirements

The follow are the requirements for eSchool students regarding participation in eSchool classes. Please be aware that participation is required as with normal school and P-scores will be used to track participation and engagement. Please see below for further details:

1. In order for students in K-5 to complete their courses during the year, they should complete 2.5% of the course each week. For students in grade 6-8, they should complete 5-6% of their courses each week. Students will be monitored weekly for participation and receive P-scores of P0-P3. A P0 means a student does not engage in the work or correspond with their teacher. P1 scores indicate that a little work is done and little correspondence with their teacher takes place. P2 scores mean students are doing their work and corresponding with their teacher, and P3 scores indicate a student is going above and beyond what is expected. If a student receives a P0 for the two (2) consecutive weeks, teachers are instructed to contact (attempt to contact) the parents/guardians to make them aware of the need for students to do their work. The contacts should be made by phone call or email, if no contact is made by phone. Teachers will document their attempts. If nobody responds to either phone or email contacts, teachers will make these attempts a second time the next day. They will document- if no response and/or contact is made, they will send the eSchool Principal the information, including their record of contact attempts, and the student's progress record.

2. The Principal will then make an attempt to contact- if he gets no response, then he will make a referral to the home liaisons. They will make or attempt to make contact through home visits and give parents/guardians their options. If things do not change, then eSchool can make the decision to un-enroll the affected student from eSchool and require them to return to their boundary school.

3. The teachers and eSchool will document- this is needed if the parents/guardians receive notice for the student to return to their boundary school.

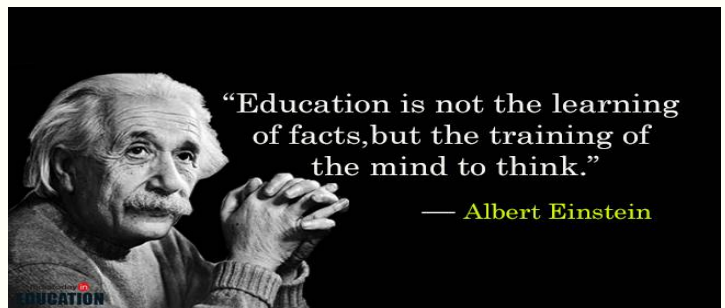
