Did you know that an Annular Solar Eclipse is coming to Utah? An Annular Solar Eclipse happens when the Moon passes between the Sun and Earth, but when it is at or near its farthest point from Earth. The Annular Solar Eclipse will occur on October 14, beginning at 10:24 a.m. in Utah. During the eclipse, the Moon's shadow will be moving at 3,897 mile per hour!! eSchool has a pair of eclipse glasses available to view the eclipse- just come by the office and pick up a pair for your student.
