## **AGENDA/Meeting Minutes**

A. Welcome: Romney Doria- Introduction to the meeting

1. Bring meeting to order: Romney Doria

Digital Citizenship Discussion: This section was tabled until this meeting.

- 2. Resources for Digital Citizenship to share with parents/students- Discuss each, Clint Smith: Discuss ideas for this area of concern- digital meeting discussion; Romney to lead discussion about some ideas he has
  - Brainpop: https://www.brainpop.com
  - Videos about holidays/other topics. Maybe teachers can send out a weekly reminder about BrainPOP/possible example of a program feature
  - Clint check into delineating logins- how many actual students are using the resource
  - o Appropriate Expenditures for eSchool Community Council: Expenditure expectations- Clint Smith: All expenditures are tied to the goals the council sets- programs, software, admissions to field trips, etc.
    - BrainPOP is \$4800/year- our digital literacy source: plus a host of other subjects
    - Vote- Clint Motion to maintain BrainPOP and i-Ready, Maria 2<sup>nd</sup>, 4-0 vote in the affirmative to purchase both programs
  - o I-Ready is around \$2900- our diagnostic for Math and Reading- interventions for struggling students-vote to purchase i-Ready. Has been funded through a grant- need to expend the monies- vote to purchase from Trustlands funds?? \$2900 for each subject- possible grant-funded Math and Trustlands
  - o Thoughts on IXL- discuss the findings by the council members- vote on purchase of IXL; \$1400/year-send message to all families about available resources for summer use. <u>Clarify that these resources are available during the school year and throughout the year, including summer.</u>

- Vote on purchase of IXL and i-Ready Language Arts: Clint- Motion to expend funds for i-Ready LA and IXL. 5-0 vote in the affirmative.
- 3. Goals discussion: Math topic of greatest need: 50% Acadience Math Meet or Exceed; RISE is 25% meet or exceed; Think about a goal for math, and how we can increase participation. Discuss and finalize goal next meeting- discussion on how to increase percentages of students meeting and exceeding RISE and Acadience Math tracking weekly those logging into Math curriculum- students not logging in during the week, email the students and parents about not logging in for the week.
